

CHAPTER 4

CONCLUSION

Based on the analysis carried out in the previous chapter, the realization of expressions containing emotions of schizophrenic sufferers on Instagram caption consists of 4 types of emotions, namely sadness, happiness, fear, and also anger. These emotional expressions are expressed either by using dennotative meaning, connotative meaning, or combination of both (connotative-dennotative meaning).

In addition, various forms of linguistic unit meanings of connotation and denotation meanings on emotional expressions of schizophrenic sufferers on the Instagram caption, including in the form of basic word forms, phrasal forms, clausal forms, and sentence forms. But the most dominant form of lingual unit denotation and connotation is the use of phrase forms.

The first conclusion based on the analysis that has been done is that people with Schizophrenia are able to express their emotions in many forms of lingual units, so it proves that they are able to convey their emotional expressions effectively in an expression. The second conclusion is that Schizophrenia sufferers tend to convey emotional expressions by using phrases. When viewed based on its syntactic function, the use of phrases is felt to be more effective in emotional expression of schizophrenics because in the expression of schizophrenic emotions in these data, phrases that contain emotions can act as subjects, predicates, or objects in sentences.

This research contributes to enriching our understanding of the forms of emotions that arise in speech, especially the emotions that Schizophrenic sufferers are trying to demonstrate. On the other hand, with the existence of this research, we can understand what the meanings of every expression that they want to express are. It is also hoped that this research can contribute to semantic analysis for the development of literature in the field of linguistics.
