Lot of people can figure out their ideas and feeling into a song.

As we know, song is a part of literature. Sometimes, people find difficulties to understand what composer means in a song, because what conventionally says is not always the same as what they are intended to express. A composer usually put the meaning implicitly. In the attempt to understand the meaning of what composer means in a song, a further knowledge is needed.

To understand the meaning and messages of a song we have to know about study of language first. The study of language is linguistic and one of linguistic aspects is idiomatic expression. One thing that we should learn to upgrading our skill of speaking in English is idiom. Idiom is an expression to describe certain condition that is not intended to be understood literally. Idiom is important to be learned and used because it can communicate something simple and interesting, in fact it can make us sounds like a native speaker. According to Hooper (1980), he states that

idiom is a number of words which, taken together, mean something different from the meanings of the words when they stand alone.

One of the artist who uses a lot of idioms in their song is Billie Eilish. Based on what the writer has written at previous chapters, that is about idiomatic expression. Actually, though idiomatic expression that exist in Billie Eilish's song, we can at least increase a little bit of our English skill, because with listen to the western song we can get new word that beautiful and it wil help us to communicate in well.

Indeed, language style that is used in English song is quite different with language style, that is used in our daily conversation, but sometimes language style like English song is also used in daily conversation to emphasize our statements. In English or western songs, usually use poetic expression to beautify they lyrics. Beside poetic expression, idiomatic expression are also found at English songs. The function of them are to give the verses or to colorful the lyrics. According to the research that the writer has done to 12 Billie Eilish selected song, with the reference to the research result, the writer take conclusions about the using idiomatic expression that are fourth point. First of all is the writer found out that from 12 selected songs there are 20 idioms which types are 18 phrasal idiom and 2 verbal idiom with with the highest number is 7 adjectival phrase and 6 noun phrase in 4 short idiom and 13 long idiom form. Second, most of Billie Eilish selected songs use in adjectival phrase and noun phrase. Third, there are some idioms that are not in the idiom dictionary yet, which can increase our acknowledge about idiom. Fourth, Billie Eilish songs is about love, loss, depression, and self-image.

Most people can sing a song, but they do not understand what the meaning in it, because lot of song, especially western use idiomatic expression to cover the true meaning behind the literal lyric, so the song would sounds more artsy. Otherwise, the word of the song sometimes have the different meaning from the literal meaning as usual. After the writer analyze the idiom expression of the Billie Eilish's song, in fact she made it easy way to find the idiom in the song. For instance : *bide my time*, *sell my soul*, *party favor*, etc that could be find in dictionaries.
