CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Problem

Language is very important in human life to express idea, knowledge, and feeling. one of the languages is English. English has become an important popular language for international communication and people always call it as an international language. Language is an effective tool to make relationship and work together. In many aspects language can be learn and one of the study language is to using a figurative language.

Figurative language is related with meaning, and the study of meaning is semantics. Kearns (2000:1) in her book says "Semantics deals with the literal meaning of words and the meaning of the way they are combined, which taken together from the core of meaning, or the starting point from which the whole meaning of a particular utterance is constructed".

Listening song is fun activity, but the listeners cannot get pleasure if they dont understand the figurative language that comonly found in song. There are some similarities between a song and a poem. A song has to be rhythmic and so Rhythm is one of the important elements in both songs and poetry. In fact, there is even a form of poetry which is made into music called a lyric poem. They can be used in songs to express the thoughts and feelings of the song writer.

Song usually consist of figurative language since the figurative languaged is used in the lyric that is writen well. The descriptive words of figurative language

has a meaning in sense other than literal, even the words convey precise meaning. The researcher analyze figurative language in Linkin Park songs.

There are many messages delivered in their songs and the language that is used to convey the messages in the song is figurative language, so the listener will be interested in listening song to obtain the purpose and the messages delivered in the song. The researcher is interested in conducting this research because usually the readers, including the researcher himself, find some difficulties in understanding the meaning of the song lyrics. Every song has messages and in order to know the message, the lyrics of the song need to be analyzed to know the meaning. The researcher chooses Linkin Park album because the song writes based on his experience, but they always very good on the words selection, so the listeners do not expect those songs are telling true stories of the band. The method which is used in this research is descriptive qualitative method. Descriptive qualitative method employs technique of seeking, collecting and analyzing data.

This study focused on the use of figurative languages in song lyrics, because many figurative languages could be analyze.
