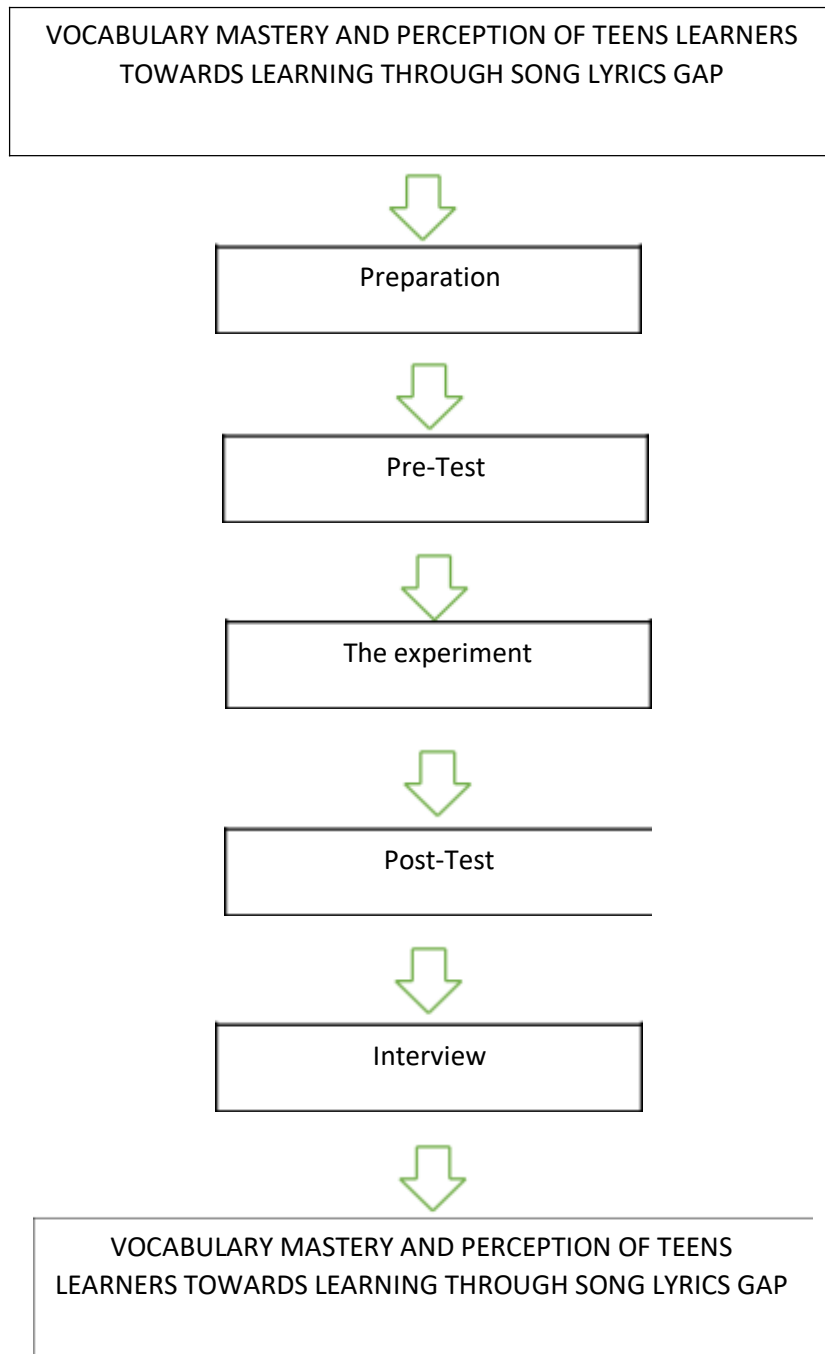

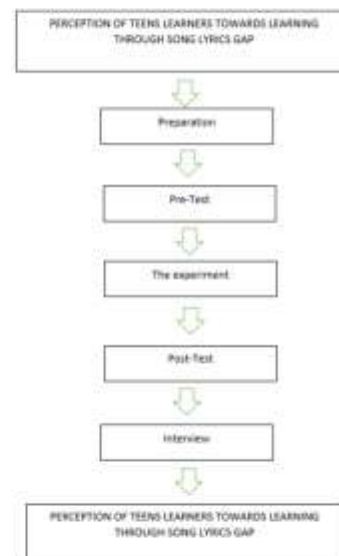
BACKGROUND

METHODS OF THE RESEARCH

DISCUSSION

Experiment shows that Song- Lyric Gap method has influence to increase students' vocabulary mastery. It can be seen from the students' scores. The average score of the Pre-test is 7,8 and the average score of the Post-test is 9,1. It means the students' average score after using the Song-Lyric Gap method is higher than before they are using the method. Also before using the method, 40% of the students' scores are below the standard that the English First Kalimalang has and after using the method none of the students are below the standard. The method shows there is an influence to the students scores.

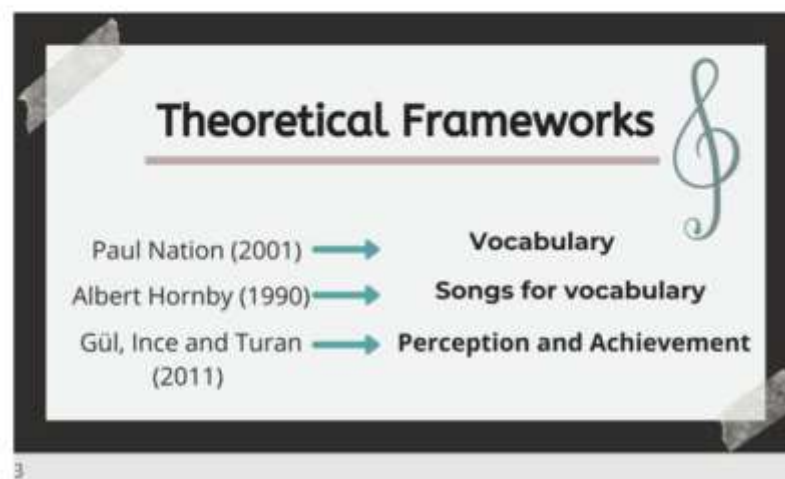
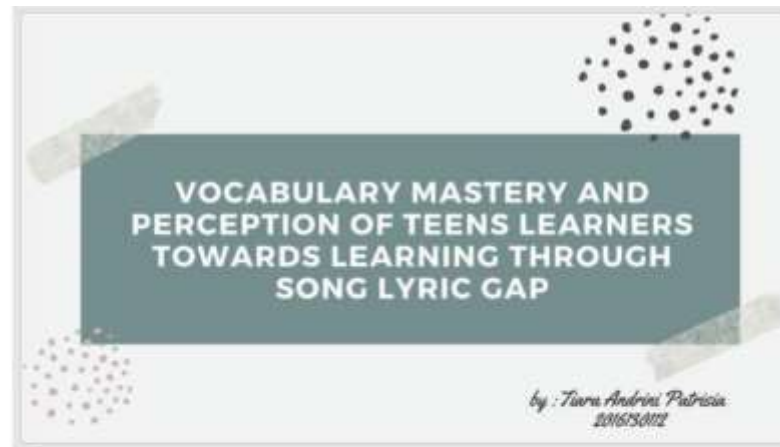

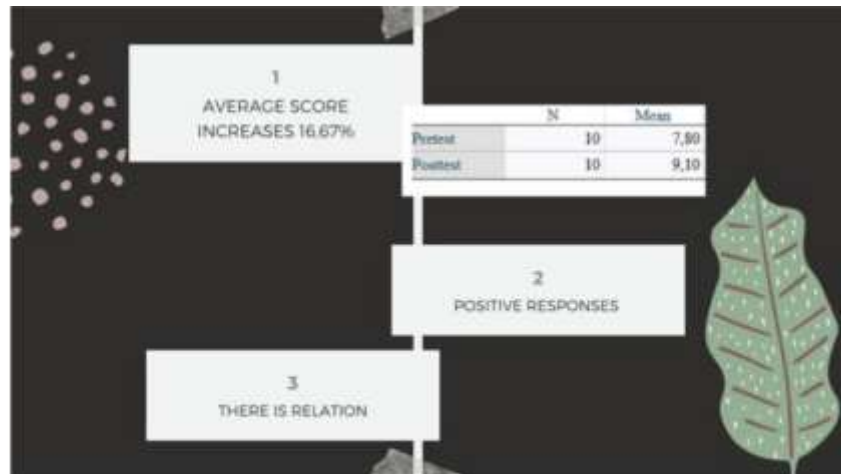
