CHAPTER I: INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

According to Deborah Tannen (as cited in medium.com) Communication is not as simple as saying what you mean. How you say what you mean is crucial, and differs from one person to the next, because using language is learned social behavior: How we talk and listen are deeply influenced by cultural experience. In particular, Lakoff (1975) argues that women's language style is deficient, lacking in authority and assertiveness. He also makes the interesting observation that women face 'double bind' where they criticized or scolded for not speaking like a lady but, at the same time, speaking like a lady systematically denies the female speaker access to power on the grounds that she is not capable of holding the ground based on her linguistic behaviour (Ibid). Lakoff (1975) mentions a list of ten women's language features. These ten types of women's language features are lexical hedges or fillers, tag question, rising intonation on declarative, empty adjectives, precise colour

term, intensifiersm hypercorrect grammar, superpolite forms, avoidance of strong swear words and emphatic stress.

Women language can be observed and analyzed in literary works, for instance, in movie because movie reflects the real situation and condition of society and movie also contains of sentences and utterance, for examples, in Ocean 8 movie. Ocean 8 is a movie about Debbie Ocean (Sandra Bullock) who is one of the members of the Ocean family who is famous for many crimes. Five years after Debbie got out of prison she planned something crazy, which was stealing a \$ 150 million diamond necklace. Debbie Ocean is a talkative person. He was cold and cooperative when she commit the crimes. In case, she talking about her theft plans she is very calm, clear and structured.
