CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of the Problem

Language is an inherent part of human life that is used to communicate with other humans in their daily lives. Language is a very important communication tool, imagine if there is no language, it is impossible for us to communicate well with another human being. Since the role of language is so important, this makes language inseparable from human life. According to Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary language is a communication system in speaking both spoken and written that is used by humans from particular countries or regions. So, there are so many variations of languages that exist in this world.

In communication there is what is called a speech act. There are three forms of speech acts that are widely known: Locution, illocution, and perlocution speech acts. Basically, speech acts are also called acts of communication that are used to express certain attitudes. In speech acts there are important things that must be

considered, namely the meaning expressed so that the listener does not misunderstand the content of the message conveyed. in speech acts the meaning conveyed by the speakers is not always the same as what is said by the speakers because there is an accompanying action. Yule (1996) states that speech acts are actions that are carried out through speech.

I am interested in analyzing speech acts because we can express our language skills appropriately according to situations and conditions by understanding speech acts. So that when in a conversation, it will reduce the occurrence of misunderstandings between the speaker and the listener. To understand more deeply about speech acts, films can be used as objects of research. Because in the film, there are examples of speech acts that are difficult to understand between the characters' conversations. In addition, this study also discusses the context of an utterance because context is an important part of analyzing an utterance. So that this research also helps in the development of pragmatic.

I want to analyze the speech acts used in "The King 2019" movie script because it has many utterances that can be analyzed using speech act theory. I chose the main character to be analyzed because the story is dominated by the main character in this movie script. Even more interesting is the difference between before becoming king and after becoming king in making utterances.

This is very good for analysis so that it can produce diverse data. The film's genre are Biography, Drama, History directed by David Michod and co-written by Michod and Joel Edgerton. The film includes an ensemble cast led by Timothee Chalamet as Henry V and is 2 hours 20 minutes long. This film tells the story of a wayward prince and heir to the throne of England, crowned King Henry V after his cruel father died. Now, the viceroy must navigate court politics, abandoned wars, and the emotional connections of his past.

1.2.Identification of the Problem

Based on the explanation above, I found "The King (2019)" movie script that sometimes the meaning of the speech does not only have literal meaning but there are actions that affect the listener. So that the reader misunderstands the meaning of the utterance. Because there are some utterances in "The King (2019) movie script that reflect the action itself, while other utterances have differences between speech and action.

1.3. Limitation of the Problem

Based on the identification of the problem, there are three limitations to avoid any deviation or widening of the main problem so that the research is more focused and easier to discuss. Hence, it makes the objectives of the research will be achieved. The analysis focuses on what types of classification of illocutionary based on the main character's utterance, specifically King Henry V based on Searle's theory, and this research is analyzed based on contexts.

- 1. What are the classifications of illocutionary act in the king Henry V's utterances in "The King 2019" movie script?
- 2. What contexts underly illocutionary acts used in the king Henry V's utterances in "The King 2019" movie script?
- 3. What Illocutionary acts are implied in the king Henry V's utterances in "The King 2019" movie script?

1.5. Objective of the Research

Based on limitation of the problems above the aims of this research can be formulated as follows:

- 1. To know the classification of illocutionary acts in the king Henry V's utterances in "The King 2019" movie script.
- 2. To Identify contexts underly Illocutionary acts used in the king Henry V's utterances in "The King 2019" movie script.

3. To Identify Illocutionary acts which are implied in the king Henry V's utterances in "The King 2019" movie script.
