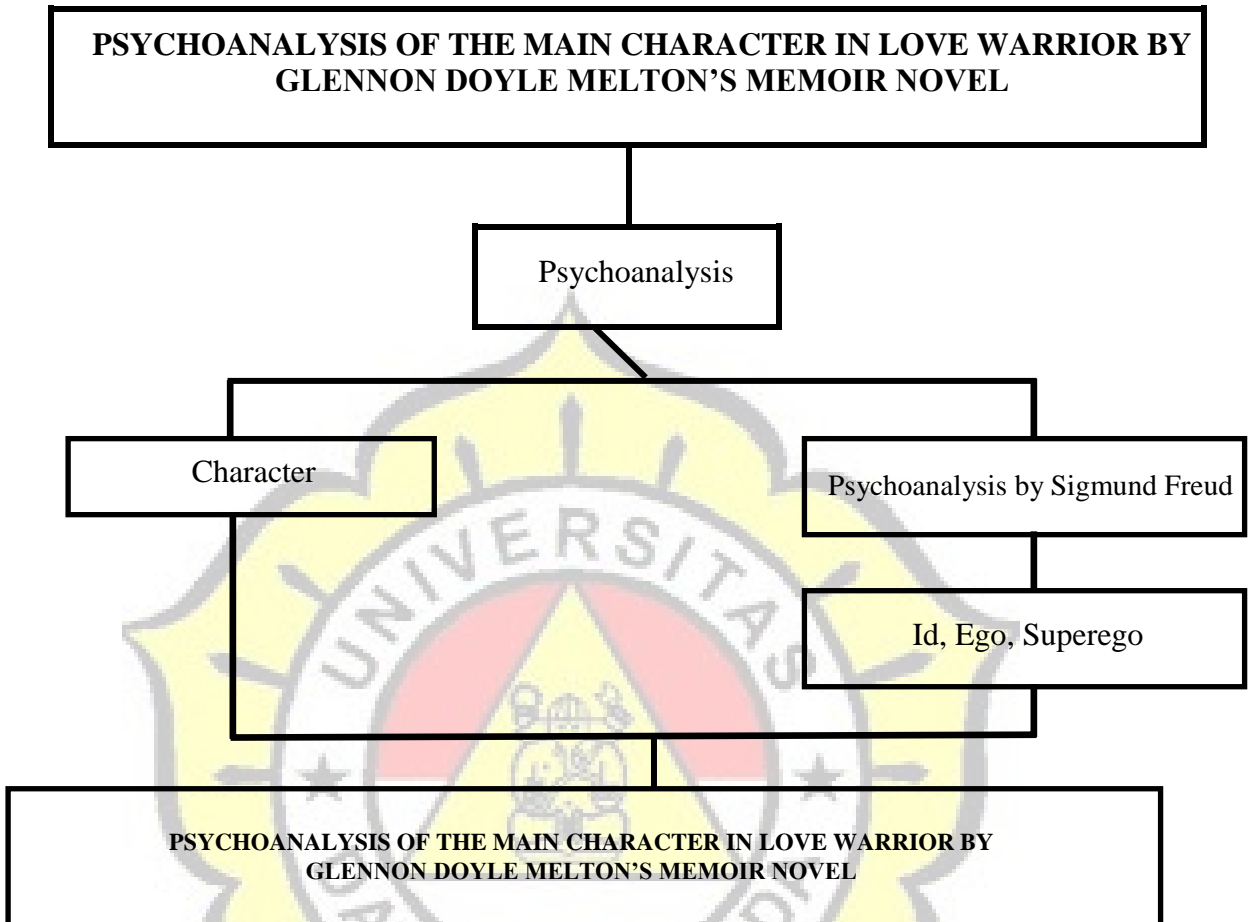


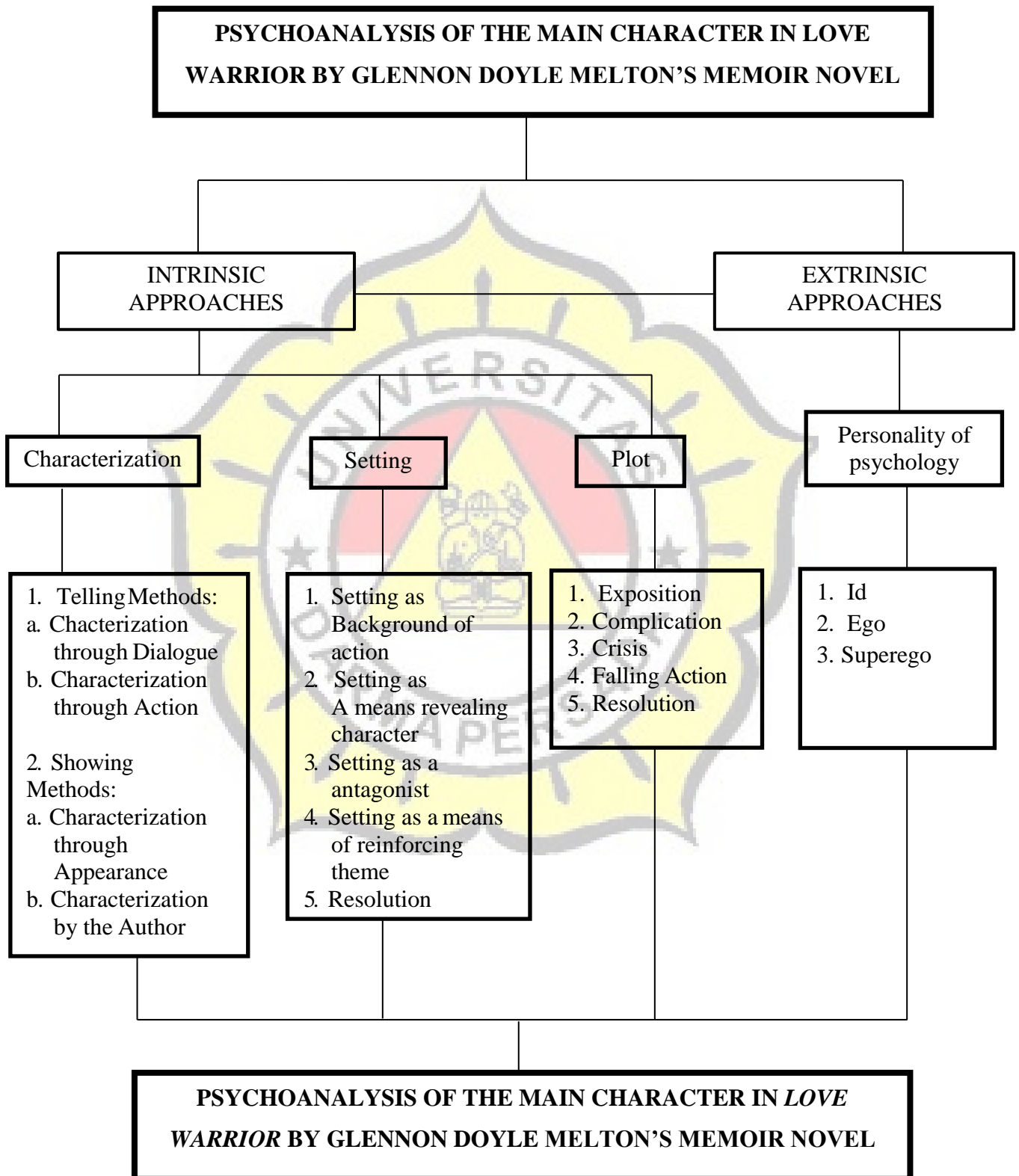

FORMULATION

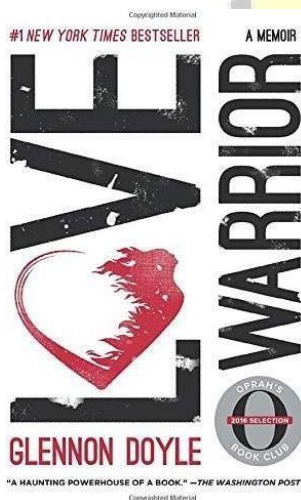
