Noxon has also received several awards and nominations by PGA Awards, Hugo Awards, Prime time Emmy Awards Noxon also directed several films and series one of which is; *To The Bone*, the movie released on January, 22 2017 this movie contains psychological genre.

Story or event that happened in this film about a young woman dealing with Anorexia Nervosa. This movie tells the story of the main character, a 20-year-old girl named Ellen who is battling anorexia Nervosa. Ellen has undergone various treatment programs, and this struggle has put pressure on her family because her condition is not getting better. Ellen used to express images related to her eating disorder on Tumblr as a way to cope with her illness. Ellen's artwork gets fans who turn to her work as an inspiration. This made Ellen quite famous on Tumblr.

However, one of the parents of Ellen's fans sent an explicit photo and a suicide note. Then, blame Ellen for this suicidal act. Hearing this incident, Ellen's Anorexia Nervosa get worst. In the end, Ellen was referred to a treatment facility to treat her illness. However, from time to time there were no significant changes because Ellen do not comply with the existing regulations and resulted in Ellen staying with her eating disorder. Ellen also feel it was futile, and fled to her biological mother's place. After realizing his decision, he returned to the place of the healing facility.

This movie has an unpredictable plot with Ellen as the main character. The movie considers psychological problems about disappointment, anxiety, and denial the reality from the main character, Ellen.
