INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the problem

The speech titled "On the Use of Chemical Weapons by Syrian Government" are riddled with doublespeak, cherry picked information, unconfirmed reports and outright lies. The true goal of the speech is of course to dehumanized and illegitimized the Syrian government and to manipulate the US population into approving an illegal attack on a sovereign nation.

The meaning of doublespeak is the manipulation of language such as deliberately obscuring the sentences, disguises, distort, make the unattractive seems attractive, in short doublespeak is a manipulation of a language of course the people who uses doublespeak knew what they are doing, hence doublespeak is not a slip of the tongue. Doublespeak is mainly used by government or advertiser to obscure the language, however the use of doublespeak are not limited by the previously mentioned. The word doublespeak derived from the book nineteen eighty-four by George Orwell, although the word doublespeak is not used in the book itself the idea of doublespeak is comparable to Orwell's idea of doublethink which is in the book. An example of a simple doublespeak is "The bottle is half full" versus "The bottle is half empty" the difference is the connotation between those two sentences, the first one has a positive connotation while the second has a negative connotation. There are many types of doublespeak, first one is euphemism, this type of doublespeak does not purposely distort the truth but rather soften the words used, an example being "Passed on" or "Passed away "instead "Died" or "Dead". The second type of doublespeak is jargon, it is a terminology which is especially defined in relation to a specific activity, profession, group, or even, of course, there are many types of jargon such as medical jargon, business jargon, military jargon, etc. An example type of jargon is a police jargon of "Code eight" which means that an officer needed help immediately.

The Syrian conflict is often mistaken labeled as civil war when in fact it is a proxy war waged by the United States against the Syrian government. As one of the executives of the United States Wesley Clark once stated these invasions against countries such as Iraq, Syria, Lebanon, Libya, Somalia. etc. are all premeditated and planned with the goal being Iran. The United States often dehumanized their target before they attacking, to justified their invasion when in fact the main goal of these US illegal military action has always been to monopolize the targeted nation's oil industry and other natural resources and their often use hide behind the notions of "it is for the greater good" or "fighting democracy" such statement can be seen in the many speeches by the United States government or even the President themself and of course they never directly said it was an attack to took control of a target nation resources, but in these speeches are often dotted with inaccurate information or just blatant lies, all of these speeches are wrapped inside a misleading doublespeak that the i want to analyze such as the on in the tittle. One of the refences i use is from The Grayzone and one of the articles that Aaron Maté written about debunking the OPCW lies.

Through this paper I want to analyze the doublespeak from a speech by Barrack Obama. This analysis will mainly focus on the doublespeak aspect of it specifically euphemism and jargon and its historical and political context on the doublespeak used in the sentence

Though everyday doublespeak is usually used in advertainment, doublespeak is also commonly used by the government, especially if they want to intentionally obscure, misled or deceive the public, but unfortunately a lot of people doesn't even know what doublespeak is hence they just accept it without knowing what is being hidden to them by the government.
