CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Research

Directed by M. Night Syamalan, *Split* tells the story of the terror experienced by three girls, namely Casey (Anya Taylor-Joy), Claire (Haley Lu Richardson), and Marcia (Jessica Sula) when they were about to go on a trip together. A stranger named Kevin Wandell Crumb (James McAvoy) suddenly drugged and then kidnapped the three of them. Casey, Claire, and Marcia were then locked up in a room somewhere. The three girls panicked and tried to find a way out. However, their efforts were not easy because Kevin was not an ordinary man and he has 23 multiple personalities.

Kevin was diagnosed by his psychiatrist as having Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID) and having 23 multiple personalities. Although diagnosed with 23 multiple personalities, there are only a few personalities that stand out, namely Kevin (real personality), Dennis (smart and likes everything clean and tidy, Particia (a motherly woman), Hedwig (a nosy 9-year-old boy, Jade (woman with diabetes), Orwell (a man who knows of history, Mr.Pritchard (professor of the film). Kevin has a lot of personality due to the torture his mother used to do when he was a child. Thanks to the help of therapy from a psychiatrist, Kevin's 23 personalities were initially able to walk in a balanced manner. Until one day, Kevin's three personalities namely Dennis, Patricia, and Hedwig planned something terrible and then formed a team within Kevin and was named The Horde.

The Horde then launched its action by kidnapping three girls, namely Claire (Jessica Sula) and Marcia (Haley Lu Richardson), and Cassie (Anya Taylor-Joy). The three girls were then placed in a closed room similar to a basement. Many times Casey, Claire, and Marcia tried to escape, at that time Kevin was always there to prevent. Kevin warned them that a monster would come to eat them. The three girls then realized that Kevin had multiple personalities because his character often changed suddenly. The goal of The Horde kidnapping the three girls is to bring Kevin's 24th personality to life, namely The Beast. After The Beast appeared, the three girls would later be bitched because The Best was a cannibal.

According to the background of the problem above, I am interested to analyze this movie script because it contains psychological problems found in the background of the movie script. This movie script uses my term paper's title which is Repression of Personality Caused by Trauma on The Main Character. I would like to analyze the main

character, Kevin, who has a psychological disorder due to his childhood trauma. Since little Kevin, he has always received harsh treatment from his biological mother.
