CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of The Research

Starling Days were positively reviewed by Eithne Farry in the Sunday Express, and The Spectator described it as " a convincing novel about depression which manages, miraculously, not to be in itself depressing" indications than Rowan is a better writer than this work would suggest and concluding that the book

"offers consolation" to readers. The book was shortlisted for the 2019 Costa Book Awards in the Novel category.

Rowan Hisayo Buchanan has achieved the rare feat, in her second novel Starling Days, she is writing a convincing novel about depression which manages, miraculously, not to be in itself depressing. The story of Starling Days is centered on the marriage of two characters, Oscar and Mina, Mina has struggle for years with her depression. Buchanan shows the story is not only about the struggle, but also how to survive from the struggle of the anxiety that can makes depression.

The initial causes of anxiety can make the main character depressed is because she experienced a traumatic or post-traumatic when she was in high school. Mina lived by the three people she loved so much, her mother, father and grandmother. Mina starts to get her medication when her grandmother died, her mother gone for so long, and her father spent his days in bookkeeping and his evening at night school. She seems like lost her protective wings. Because of that all, Mina feels lonely, lack of attention from her family and she also feel lonely through her days and started feeling anxious, so she took the med to relieve her depression and until she have married with Oscar she still always have feel emotional exhaustion with her household and also with her life.

Mina and Oscar have married in the last six years. Oscar is a kind husband, but he always busy with his work as a businessman, at sometimes when Mina wants to tell about all her problem life, her husband often ignores her because he is busy, so Mina thinks that Oscar doesn't have time for Mina. Mina feels that her relationship with the man she has been for long years does not make her happy. She is really lack of attention from her family in the past and now also from her husband.

Sometimes, Mina reveals to Oscar about her condition that she has convicted by the gynecologists that she have disorders of ovaries that made it difficult to get pregnant, and there is no effort given by Oscar other than just telling her to always checking up. Her anxiety starts to rise up after know about that. After that all happen to their life, Mina has attracted with her new woman friend but her friend is refuse her, and she is confess to Oscar, got to know that, Oscar is shock. Oscar did not expect that his wife doing something unexpected things to vent her anxious. After

he hear about the explanation from Mina, Oscar decide to divorce Mina. Mina has lost all the important person one by one, starts from she leaves by her parents, get the refusal from her new friend, and also get the divorce from her husband at the same time. Then it makes Mina's emotions slowly started to rise again and returned to depression. Her personality change because of bad habits that she had. It also makes her life is never be calm in every situation.

In this research, I am interested in analyzing this novel because it contains psychological problems found in the background of the novel. Through the novel, we can find out the main character, Mina and Oscar as a household who experience several problems in life that must make them survive from all disturbances. The fact of human personality is clearly seen in this novel. There are quite a few that makes this novel's message worth to be analyze.
