Background of The Research




The novel entitled *The Perfect Child* by Lucinda Berry published in 2019 is one of a literary work that tells about trauma and psychopath.

Formulation of The Problem


- 1. What are the characterization of the characters through showing methods in Lucinda Berry's Novel *The Perfect Child*?

In extrinsic approach, there are 2 concepts to support the theme of my analysis.




Trauma

Nancy Boyd Webb in her book *Mass Trauma and Violence*, states that trauma is expressed as pain experienced by someone who can damage physical and psychological so that it brings difficulties to life such as decreased levels of productivity and daily activities. (Webb, 2004)
