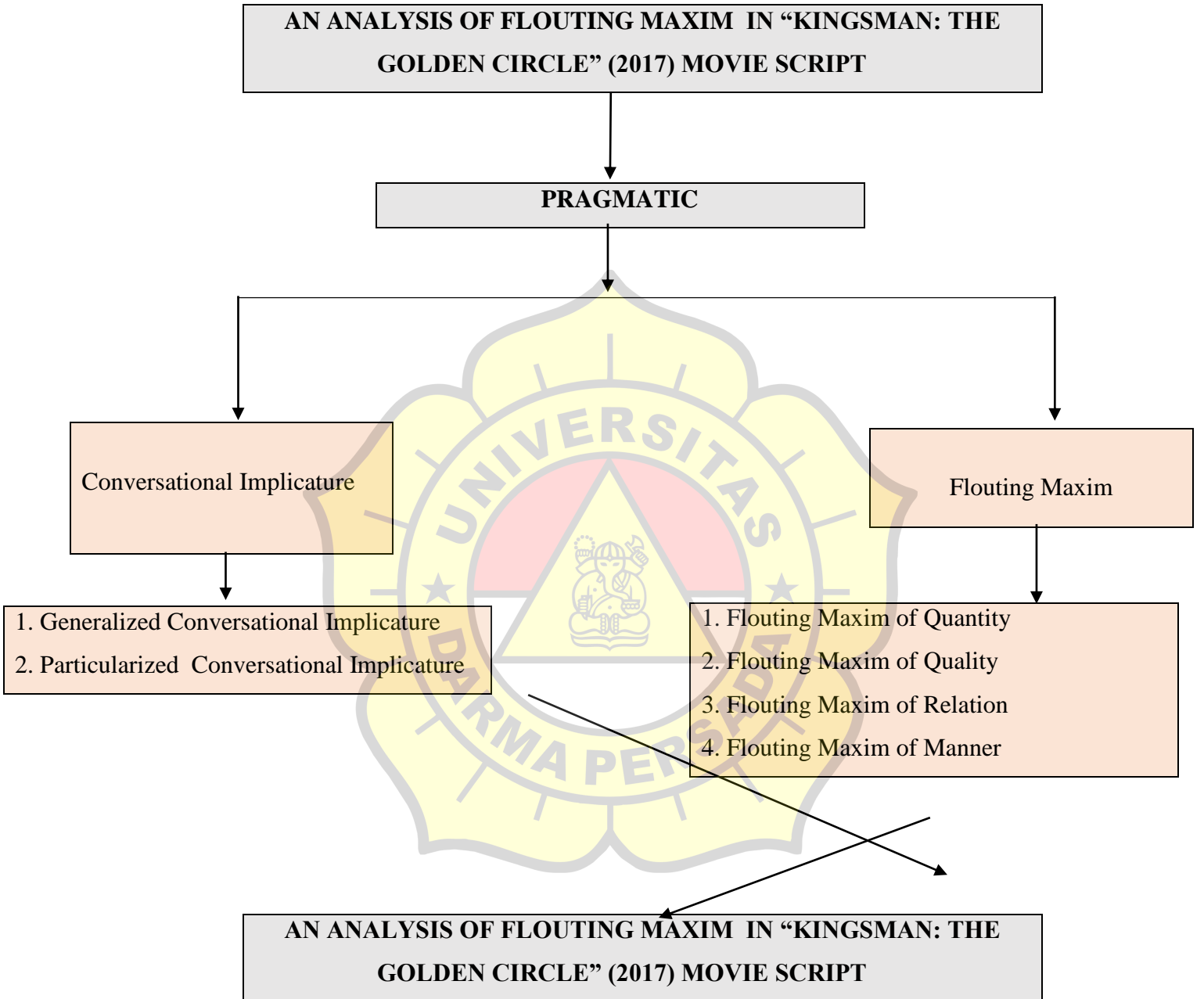

1 BACKGROUND OF THE PROBLEM

This chapter finds the types of conversational implicature in the form of the generalized of conversational implicature and the particularized of conversational implicature. In this result, it was found that there were 8 types of the generalized conversational implicature and 7 types of the particularized conversational implicature. Most of conversational implicature rises because the character flouts maxim of quantity and manner. The second conclusion. Based on the findings and discussion in the previous chapter, the researcher concludes that in the film "Kingsman: The Golden Circle" there are about 15 conversations that flouting the maxim of quantity, 2 utterances that flouting the maxim of quality, 11 utterances that flouting the maxim of relationship, and utterances that flouting the maxim of method.
