CONCLUSION

After I analyzing Of Precognition By main Character Minty In The Harriet Movie script through the intrinsic approach, which consisting of characterization, plot, and setting of the story elaborated with analysis through extrinsic approach using the theory of precognition and discrimination, it can be concluded that Precognition By main Character Minty movie script can be analyzed through a Literary Psychological Approach.

The showing through dialogue and showing through plot method is a method used to analyze the character of a Minty in the Harriet film. It can be proven that Minty character has an ability, namely Precognition. The character is proven through precognitive analysis of the character.

Dialogue and plot are used to analyze Minty's precognition ability in Harriet's film. Minty is one of the black slaves who works in a white garden. When they approach Mr. Brodess, the owner of the estate, he tears up the letter and viciously refuses the request. Minty weeps and prays to God for Mr Brodess to die - which she does shortly after. His son, Gideon, who grew up with Minty, hear Minty's pray and his so angry. He decided to sell Minty downstream, where she would never see her family or husband again. She decided to flee north. Since then Minty embarked on a journey far north on a very dangerous journey alone until Minty was finally able to free the other slaves.

The concept of the literary psychology used in the analysis of the main character's precognition in Harriet film is her ability. All the concepts are elaborated with an intrinsic approach, namely characterizations, plot, and setting methods.

The moral of this research is that someone who is close to God can be given guidance; can be given the ability or patience.
