She was born June 26, 1993 at Boca Raton, Florida, U.S. According to (Britannica, 2022.), she is American pop singer and actress who burst onto the pop music scene within the early 2010s and got to be one of the genre's most successful performers, known for her four-octave range. Grande started singing and acting when she was young. While pursuing her acting career, Grande perfected her singing. In 2011 she released the single "Put Your Hearts Up". Her debut album, Yours Truly, showed up two a long time later, and it included the popular single "The Way," a collaboration with rapper Mac Mill operator. The album debuted at number one on the Billboard 200 chart and was broadly praised. With this success, Grande started to move her center to music. Her second album, My Everything, was released in 2014, and it established her as a pop star.

I am interested in analyze this Positions album because this album was released on October 30, 2020, and occupied the top 4th most streamed album released in 2020 on Spotify. This study will focus on Lexical Cohesion used Ariana Grande's songs in Positions album. This study will take all the song lyrics in positions album.
