1.1. Background of the Problem

Lexical meanings are actual meanings, meanings that are following the results of our sensory observations, or meaning as they are, while contextual meanings are the meanings of a lexeme or words that are in one context (Chaer, 2012:289-290).

In this study, I choose selected songs by Demi Lovato in her album "DEMI" in 2013 as an object of this research. The "DEMI 2013" album is the most hits album among her other albums. According to Biography online (Biography,2017, paragraphs 2-14), Demetria Devonne Lovato (Demi Lovato) is an American singer, songwriter, and actress. After appearing on the children's television series Barney & Friends as a child (Angela) in 2002, Demi Lovato debuted as a singer in 2008. Demi Lovato also holds one Guinness World Record and was included on the Time 100 annual list in 2017. In November of 2010, Demi checked herself into rehab in the middle of a Camp Rock Tour to get treatment for severe depression, bulimia, anorexia, and cutting. Demi got out in January of 2011, and while she was in treatment, she was diagnosed with bipolar disorder. She had these problems since she was 11 years old. Overall her achievement is still regarded as a bright one at her 22 years old considering in 2008, Demi Lovato covered the Academy Award-nominated song, "That's How You Know".

1.2. Identification of the Problem

Based on the background of the problem above, I identify Demi Lovato pours everything that she has been through or is feeling through into the song lyrics that can be confusing to the listener. In this study, I focus on analyzing the dimension of meaning in the lyric of selected songs. In this case, a word may have more than one meaning, not only literal but also based on lexical and contextual meanings, which is called the dimension. Lexical and contextual meaning is one semantics topic that considers many kinds of meaning that a word had, supported by lexical and contextual meaning, in English language study, to express meaning.

1.3. Limitation of the Problem

Based on the identification of the problem, I focus on contextual meaning in semantics. This research will find out the meaning that exists in lyrics of "Demi" songs from the contextual meaning. From that album, I will choose seven songs, the songs which are analyzed through lexical and contextual meaning are only seven selected songs written by Demi Lovato in her album, "Demi". Those are Heart Attack, Never Been Hurt, Warrior, Something that we're not, In Case, Neon Lights, and Made in USA.
