CHAPTER 5 CONCLUSION

After analyzing the script of *The Devil All The Time* movie through an intrinsic approach, which consists of characterizations using a dramatic showing method, plot and setting, it is elaborated by an extrinsic approach analysis using the concepts of Behaviourism; Stimulus, Response, and Effect. It can be concluded that Antonio Campos's movie script entitled *The Devil All The Time* Can be analyzed through Psychology Behaviourism. The results of the intrinsic approach that I elaborate with this extrinsic approach prove that the theme of this research is Behaviourism Reflected in *The Devil All The Time* Movie Script By Antonio Campos.

The Dramatic showing method is a method used to analyze the characterizations of the characters in Antonio Campos's movie script, entitled *The Devil All The Time*. This can be proven in the character of Arvin Eugene Russell, he is a rational person, thinking logically, and adaptive. These characterizations will prove stimulus, response and effect of this movie script.

Plot and Setting are used to analyze this Antonio Campos's movie script entitled *The Devil All The Time*. The exposition begins when The Russell's is introduced by the narrator and living a normal family life. Complication comes after Arvin's mother is diagnosed by cancer and death. Crisis of this film comes when Arvin is killed the preacher. The falling action is when Arvin want to give proper burial to his dog, Jack. The concept of Behaviourism used in Antonio Campos's movie script entitled *The Devil All The Time* is consist of stimulus, response, and effect.
