The first findings there are several ways characterization conveyed by the author, by showing method and Characterization through Dialogue and Characterization through Action. Elsa's characters are brave, leadership, independent, and sacrificing. Anna's characters are optimistic, believe, quick-witted, and cheerfulness. The second finding is that based on the analysis of Frozen II Movie Script by focusing toward moral values shown by Anna and Elsa as the main characters it tends to be presumed that there are several kinds of moral values that were related theory from Buzan as follows; Bravery, Honesty, Steadfastness, Sympathetic, Cooperativeness, Thankfulness, Kind Hearted, and Love and Affection.

The third finding is that which moral value that is more dominant in Frozen II movie script that was conveyed by main character. As known that this movie is for children so that is why it will give moral value that educate children. Between listed moral value Bravery, Honesty, Steadfastness, Sympathetic, Cooperativeness, Thankfulness, Kind Hearted, and Love and Affection. The most dominant moral value presented by those main character is bravery value as it can be seen in the

moral findings that showed majority value presented in the movie were value of bravery. Bravery is the capacity to go to bat for common decency in tough spots. People need bravery to face their fears and overcome the obstacles in their life.
