CONCLUSIONS

In this chapter describe the conclusion of the analysis according to the analysis of the conflict external and the resolution on Jurassic World Fallen Kingdom Movie based on the plot. Moreover, this chapter describe the suggest for the next study who will do the similar study, based on the object or the analysis.

In composing of the story, the research used a content analysis approach in the research, which used plots as the basis for determining conflicts and their resolution. The conflict studied is an external conflict. In external conflict, researchers found two types of conflict, namely man versus man and man versus nature. The man versus man conflict happened on Owen Graddy, Claire Dearing, and Maisie Lockwood with Eli Mills who known as the right-hands of Benjamin Lockwoods, and Ken Wheatley who known as the right-hands Eli Mills. Meanwhile the man versus nature happened on Owen Graddy and Claire Dearing with the eruption of Mt. Sibo and the dinosaurs at Isla Nublar.

Also, there are four conflict resolution that found. There are three conflict resolution found in man versus man conflict namely, accommodating, avoiding, and compromising.
