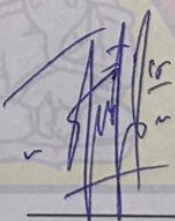


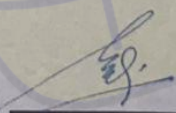

ABSTRACT

This study investigates gender performativity that breaks the norm of the social construction that exist in Disney's *Mulan* (2020) movie script. there are two main objectives in this study. The first objective is to describe the reflections of the main character breaking gender roles through utterances spoken by other characters in Disney's *Mulan* movie script. The second objective is to analyze the reflection of the main character when she breaks gender stereotypes shown in Disney's *Mulan* movie script. This study used qualitative approach with a qualitative descriptive method because it describes the reflection shown by the main character contains gender performativity spoken by characters in Disney's *Mulan* movie script. The object of this study is Disney's *Mulan* movie script. The research data re collected from the dialogue between characters in Disney's *Mulan* movie script. The result of this study proven that the main character breaks both gender roles and gender stereotypes shown in characters utterances. There are 10 data classified as gender-role breaking, and the gender role-breaking is determined based on the utterances by the main character which reflect breaking the roles of genders according the constructed society that people set from time to time. There are 40 data classified as gender stereotypes-breaking, and gender stereotypes-breaking is determined based on the utterances by the main character which reflect the stereotypes people set as feminine and masculine. It can be concluded that the main character in Disney's *Mulan* movie script breaks gender roles and gender stereotypes constructed by the society to create her identity as a woman.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini membahas tentang performativitas gender yang merusak norma dari konstruksi sosial yang terjadi dalam naskah film Disney Mulan. Terdapat dua tujuan utama dalam penelitian ini. Tujuan yang pertama adalah untuk mendeskripsikan cerminan pemeran utama dalam proses merusak peran gender melalui ucapan yang diujarkan oleh pemeran lain dalam naskah film Disney Mulan. Tujuan kedua adalah menganalisa cerminan dari pemeran utama ketika merusak stereotipe gender berdasarkan karakteristik tradisional yang terjadi di naskah film Disney Mulan. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif dengan metode deskriptif kualitatif karena hasil analisis data yang disajikan menggambarkan cerminan pemeran utama yang mengandung performativitas gender yang diujarkan oleh pemeran lain dalam naskah film Disney Mulan. Objek penelitian ini adalah naskah film Disney Mulan. Data penelitian ini dikumpulkan dari percakapan antara pemeran dalam naskah film Mulan. Hasil penelitian ini membuktikan bahwa pemeran utama merusak peran gender dan stereotipe gender yang terlihat di ujaran pemeran lain. Terdapat 10 data yang diklasifikasikan menjadi peran gender yang dirusak oleh pemeran utama berdasarkan ujaran yang mencerminkan dirusaknya peran gender menurut lingkungan masyarakat dari waktu ke waktu. Terdapat 40 data yang diklasifikasikan menjadi stereotipe yang dirusak oleh pemeran utama berdasarkan ujaran yang mencerminkan dirusaknya stereotipe gender yang dicerminkan sebagai feminin dan maskulin. Dapat disimpulkan bahwa pemeran utama dalam naskah film Disney Mulan telah merusak peran gender dan stereotipe gender sosial yang terkonstruksi untuk membangun identitasnya sebagai perempuan.
