CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Problem

Throughout the history of life, women have been regarded as weak figures, both in their work and in building their self-image. Since birth, a baby demands a woman, we can know that a man needs a woman and vice versa. According to (Allanana & Makama, 2013: 121), one group stated that women have a lower status and less authority because their roles are only related to the domestic arena, while men's roles are more visible in the public arena. Jo as the central character in this movie script shows that her independent character is beautiful, strong, brave, ambitious, and has high self-confidence. She is a woman who has "character" and is in control of her own life, in achieving everything to gain power. Through this depiction, it can be seen that the author conceptualizes Jo's to be a smart person and does not want to lose, so that researchers are interested in analyzing this character because Jo' as a female character in this movie is equivalent to men because the nature of not wanting to lose is very much identified with men in social construction as a fact currently available.
