INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of the Problem

Love, Simon is a 2018 American romantic comedy-drama film directed by Greg Berlanti, written by Isaac Aptaker and Elizabeth Berger, and based on the novel Simon vs. Homo Sapiens Agenda by Becky Albertalli. The film stars Nick Robinson, Josh Duhamel and Jennifer Garner. The movie tells the story of Simon Spier, a reclusive gay teenage boy in high school who is forced to hide his identity from his friends and family, while trying to discover the identity of his unknown schoolmate, has fallen in love with Simon through online.

This movie script tells how Simon Spier as the main character tries to hide his sexual identity acting like a "normal" man in general.
