

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Problem

Talking about speech acts, speech acts also can be said the study of intended meaning the utterances spoken and written. Furthermore, the most important things in speech acts are the message conveyed by the speaker, so the hearer is able to understand the message from the speaker. There are

three types of speech acts; those are locutionary act, illocutionary act, and perlocutionary act. The utterances spoken by the speaker or the actions taken by the speaker in each conversation are called speech acts. In interacting, speech acts is significant for everyone. By studying speech acts, it can make people be able to make comprehend of what messages are conveyed or discovered in every utterance.

Yule (1996) states that speech acts are a study of how the speakers and hearers use language. Generally, in the conversation or utterances there is a speech acts. The utterances in the movie script could be great example of speech acts. Mostly, speech acts occurred in dialogue among the characters. Speech acts indirectly affect a someone's character. When people say, express, convey, tell, ask, or order something, it builds their character. The development of someone's character is created on how they speak to the others and comprehend the meaning. Same thing as in movie script, the utterances that occurred in there affect all the characters, especially on the main character. I use the movie script in this research as a source of the data. The movie script that I choose is *Encanto* (2021).

Encanto is a animated musical fantasy comedy which was released in 2021 and written by Jared Bush and Charise Castro Smith. *Encanto* tells the tale of an extraordinary family, the Madrigals, who live hidden in the mountains of Colombia, in a magical house, in a vibrant town, in a wondrous, charmed place called an Encanto. The magic of the Encanto has blessed every child in the family with a unique gift from super strength to the power to heal-every child except one, Mirabel. But when she discovers that the magic surrounding the Encanto is in danger, Mirabel decides that she, the only ordinary Madrigal, might just be her exceptional family's last hope. (IMDb, 2021).

Different understanding could happen between the speaker and the listener when they communicate, it is not only found in everyday life, but also found in a movie. To understand or comprehend the meaning of an utterances, people need to know the context. By understanding the context, so the meaning and intention can be conveyed. I

use movie script in this research because movie script contains full of conversation that indicate speech acts.
