CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of the Problem

Most people have a terrible experiences in their lives. The experiences can be bad for those as the experiences cause trauma symptom. Trauma is emotional distress due to an unpleasant incident. Retrieved by (American Psychological Association: 2013) trauma is an emotional response to a terrible event that physically or emotionally threatening or harmful. A traumatized person can feel a range of emotions immediately after the event and in the long term. Harvey (2002:5) stated that the real effect that will be faced by someone who has traumatic experience is known as Post Traumatic Stress Disorder or PTSD.

Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder is the psychological disorder after experiencing the trauma. Retrieved by (American Psychiatric Association: 2022) an individual may experience this as emotionally or physically harmful or life-threatening and may affect mental, physical, and social such as natural disasters, serious accidents, war, and sexual assault. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder develops differently from person to person. While the symptoms of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder most commonly develop in the hours or days following the traumatic event, it can sometimes take weeks, months, or even years before they appear. In human life, many people feel trauma due to their past, for example war veterans which based on a book entitled Veterans and Military Mental Health Issues published in 2022 explains that around 16 percent of soldiers deployed to Afghanistan and Iraq have Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder.

The issue of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder that occurs in human life attracts the attention of Hollywood writers to bring the theme of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder into a work. Movie script is a literary work that has a similar structure to drama. A movie script also has a setting, plot, characterization, and theme. However, the writing technique is slightly different from drama writing. In a movie script, there are not too many monologues like in a drama, and the characterizations are mostly described with dialogues between the characters in the movie script, because the result will be a visualization of the movie script itself. Movie scripts can be produced in the form of original preparations or adaptations of existing writing such as literary works. Thus, literary works are part of the media that are quite important in conveying messages to audiences.

Cherry (2021) movie script by Angela Russo-Otstot and Jessica Goldberg is an example of a literary work that contains the theme of Post-Traumatic Disorder. The movie script outlines the story of Cherry as the main character who lived his youth as a student, until then he joined the Army as a servant of the state in the war health team. Cherry's life then became chaotic and ruined when he was trapped as a drug addict because he needs the drugs for help to calm him down when the Symptoms of Post-traumatic Stress Disorder that he experiences appear.
