INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of The Problem

Screenwriters are creative professionals who specialize in writing and developing screenplays for film, either on the basis of an original idea or as an adaptation from a book or story that has already been told through another medium. Movie scripts are written by screenwriters.

With Bryan Woods, Scott Beck, and Krasinski, John Krasinski wrote, directed, and co-wrote the script for the 2018 American post-apocalyptic horror film *A Quiet Place*. Krasinski took over as director for this film. There are deaf monsters with a keen sense of hearing in this post-apocalyptic world, and the story follows a father (played by Krasinski) and a mother (played by Emily Blunt) who are doing their best to survive and raise their children (played by Millicent Simmonds and Noah Jupe). The vast majority of Earth's human population has been wiped out by a race of aliens who are blind but have excellent hearing. Evelyn and Lee Abbott of New York raise their four children, deaf daughter Regan and hearing sons Marcus and Beau, on a farm in the woods. They've avoided extinction by doing things like laying sand paths so they don't have to crunch through leaves and communicating with each other using American Sign Language rather than speaking. When the family goes to the local town to get some necessities, Beau discovers a toy space shuttle, but his father tells him to put it back because of the noise it makes. Just as they are about to leave, Regan sneakily returns the toy to him, but she forgets to include the batteries. They

leave, and Beau returns to get the batteries and store them. Beau secretly fires up the toy space shuttle on the way back to his house, which then starts making a racket. The noise awakens an animal, which rushes out of the woods to kill the man. Almost a year after Beau's death, the family appears to have returned to normalcy, and Evelyn is now several months pregnant.

John Burke Krasinski is a well-known American actor and filmmaker. On October 20, 1979, he was born into this world. His breakthrough came when he played office worker Jim Halpert on the hit NBC comedy series *The Office*. Throughout the show's nine-season run, he also served as producer and occasionally directed episodes. Krasinski received his theater training at Brown University and the National Theater Institute. He has received numerous honors, including four Primetime Emmy nominations and two Screen Actors Guild Awards. Krasinski's horror film *A Quiet Place*, which he co-wrote, directed, and starred in, received critical acclaim in 2018. In the same year, he began playing the title character, Jack Ryan, in the suspenseful Amazon series *Jack Ryan*, which he also produces.

He was nominated for a Screen Actors Guild Award for Outstanding Performance by a Male Actor in a Drama Series for his work in the drama series. Emily Olivia Leah Blunt is a British film and television actress. She was born in the United Kingdom on February 23, 1983. She has received numerous awards, including a Golden Globe and a Screen Actors Guild Award, as well as nominations for three British Academy Film Awards. She has received numerous awards, including the Golden Globe. She was named one of the world's highest-paid actresses by Forbes in 2020. Blunt first appeared in front of an audience as an actress in a stage production of "The Royal Family" in 2001. Following that, she appeared as Queen Catherine Howard in the television films *Boudica* (2003) and *Henry VIII: The Miniseries* (2003). Her first feature film was the drama *My Summer of Love*, in which she made her debut (2004). Blunt's breakthrough roles as the lead character in both the television film *Gideon's Daughter* and the comedy-drama film *The Devil Wears Prada* gave her her first taste of film success in 2006. Her performance in the former earned her a Golden Globe nomination for Best Supporting Actress, while her performance in the latter

earned her a BAFTA nomination for Best Actress in a Supporting Role. In addition to acting in films and television series, John Krasinski has done voice-over work for animated and documentary films. Among these films are *Monsters University* and *Shrek the Third*, in which he played a minor role. Sunday Night Productions is the name of his production company, which he founded in 2013. Emily Blunt, an English actress, is married to John Krasinski, and the couple has two children.
