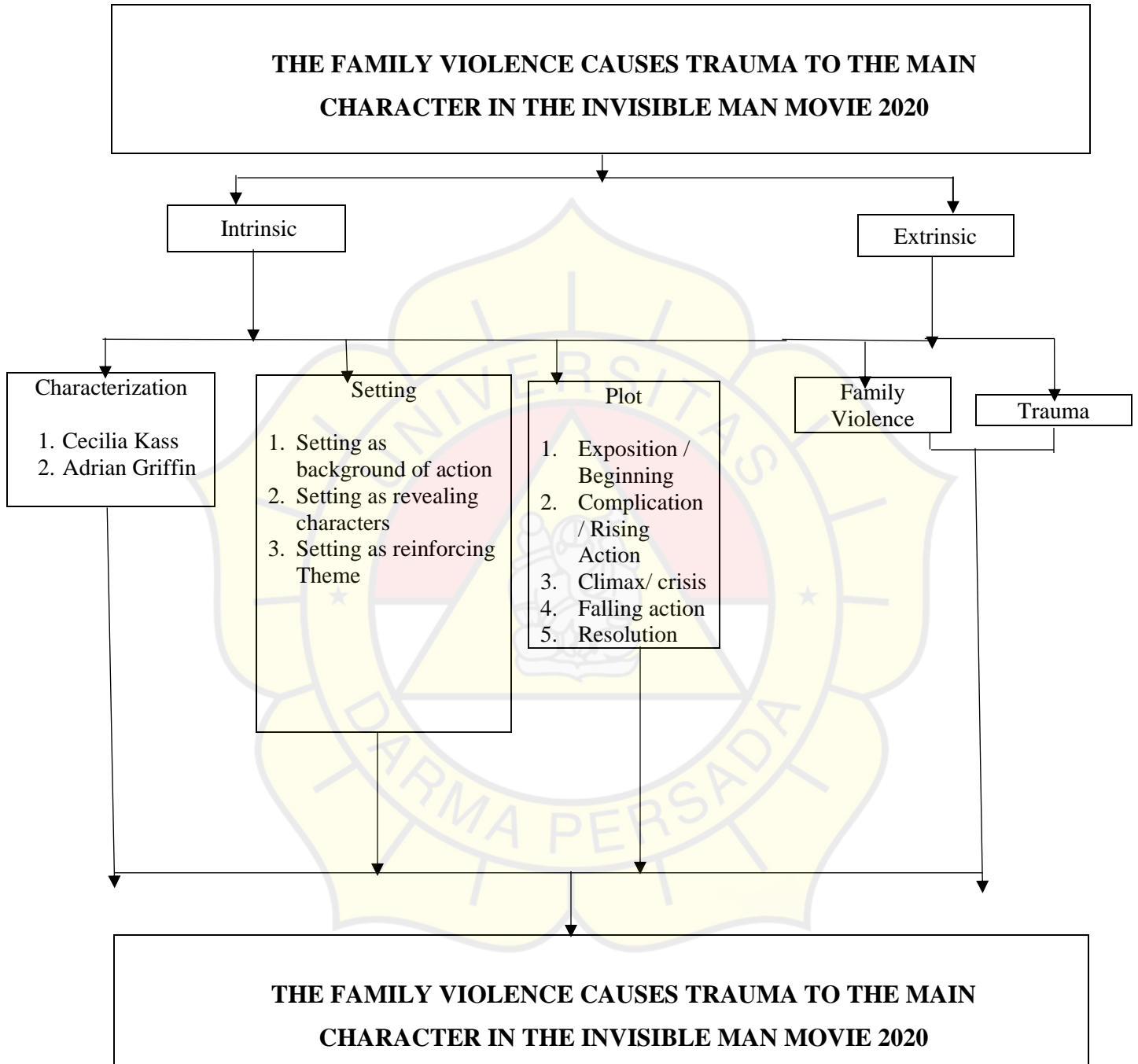



I identify several problems, including physical violence that ends the murder of the family and especially Cecilia, his wife who causes trauma.

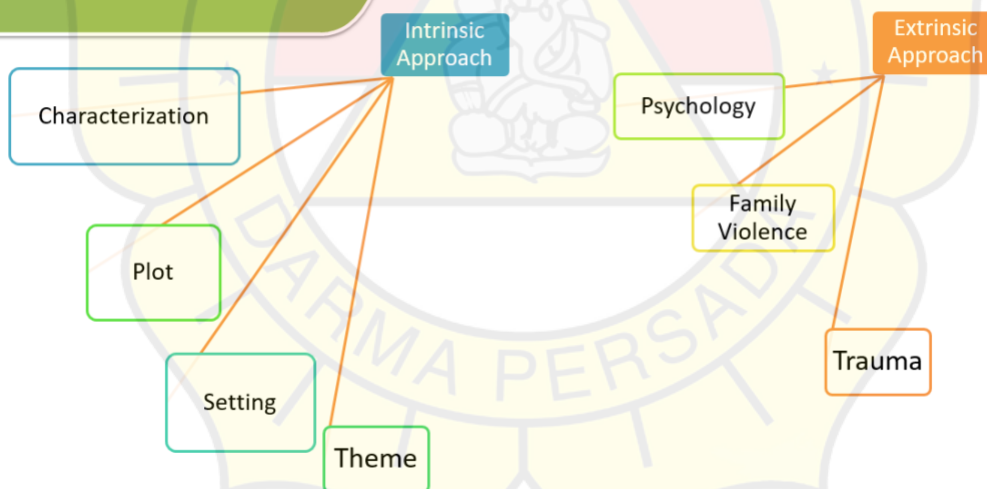

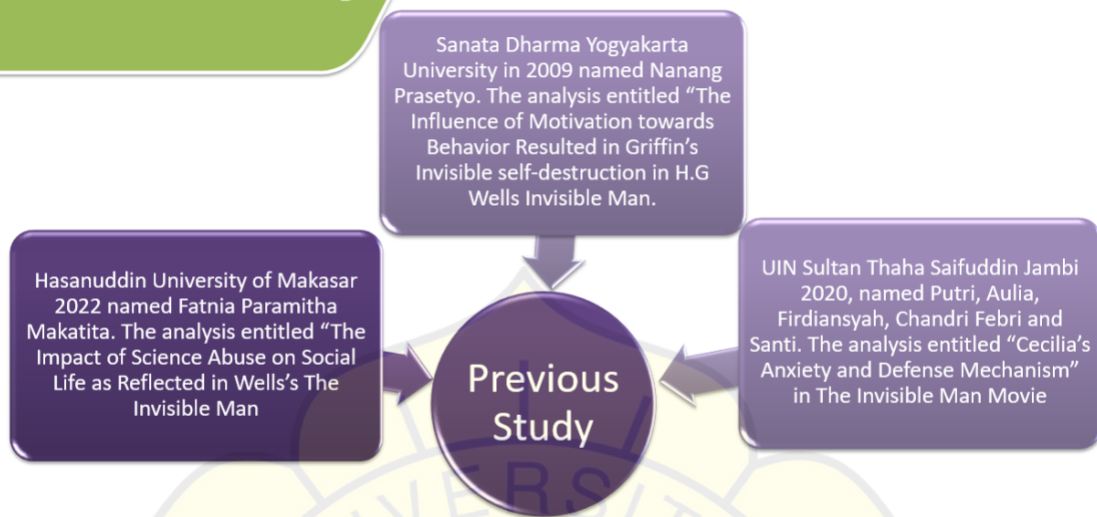

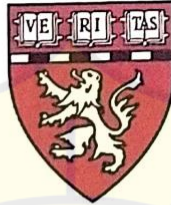
