1.1 Background of the Problem

In addition, understanding politeness factors is important for both the speaker and the hearer. Every language has a unique style of expressing politeness, thus people should be aware of these differences, especially English as a Foreign Language learners. According to Spolsky and Holmes (as cited by Marsih: 2010: 2), being polite means considering other people's feelings, hence being polite means creating a comfortable environment for others. Linguistically, being polite implies using language that is appropriate.

The appropriate speaking style in various communities are clearly quite different in a range of areas, according to Holmes (as cited by Marsih: 2010: 3). The phenomenon of linguistic politeness in several cultures is presented here. From one language to another, there may be differences in how individuals ask questions or even greet one another. A greeting that is appropriate in one country might not be suitable in another. For instance, a Chinese met his Germanic colleague, then he greeted, "Where are you going?" and his friends answered, "Of course, I'm going to the class. Why do you ask?". For the Chinese and Indonesian, the expression "Where are you going" is an informal and friendly greeting. For some European or western countries, it is an excessive curiosity, in proportion to Mulyana (as cited by Marsih, 2010: 4).

Based on the explanation above, I decided to do research in pragmatics. If we want to have so many friends in college, we have to be polite. Lastly, I choose *Spider-Man: No Way Home* because I love Marvel, their movies, their series, and their comics. This newest Spider-Man movie is amazing and talks about when the entire world knows about Peter Parker's secret identity.
