The first few tracks may sound catchy and easy listening. Being Funny in a Foreign Language is the fifth studio album by English band the 1975. It was released on 14 October 2022 by Dirty Hit. The album was recorded primarily at Real World Studios in Wiltshire.

Then the track with the title "Oh Caroline" caught my attention. The first impression that we get from the lyric is someone who is willing to do anything for his beloved. If we explore deeper, I think the meaning of the song is more than that, because there are several points in the lyrics that can be considered. I also decided to browse this song on Google, but there is no article that discusses its meaning. So on their YouTube channel. Therefore, because of my interest in the songs on this album, as well as for the purposes of disciplining, I decided to analyze the meaning of the songs and analyze the Deixis in it.

Deixis, which frequently occurs in communication, has been identified as the focus of this study. Numerous deictic words are evident in the songs featured on The 1975's album titled "Being Funny in A Foreign Language

The objective of this research is to employ a linguistic approach in order to analyze deixis within the lyrics of the songs featured on The 1975's album, "Being Funny In A Foreign Language." The album comprises 11 songs selected from their fifth album with the same title. The song titles are as follows: (1) The 1975, (2) Happiness, (3) Looking for Somebody (to Love), (4) Part of the Band, (5) Oh Caroline, (6) I'm in Love with You, (7) All I Need to Hear, (8) Wintering, (9) Human Too, (10) About You, (11) When We Are Together.

1.4 Formulation of the Problem

In this research, the problems to be investigated are formulated as the following questions:

1. What are types of deixis in the song lyrics of The 1975's "Being Funny In A Foreign Language" album?
2. How does the use of deixis affects the meaning of the whole lyrics in The 1975's "Being Funny In A Foreign Language" album?

1.5 Objectives of the Research

Based on the formulation of the problems mentioned earlier, the objective of the research are as follows:

1. To identify the types of deixis in the song lyrics of The 1975's "Being Funny In A Foreign Language" album
2. To identify how the usage of deixis affects the meaning of the whole lyrics in

The 1975's "Being Funny In A Foreign Language" album.
