CHAPTER 5 CONCLUSION

Based on the analysis of deixis in the chapter 4, there a lot of deictic word and deictic expressions that are shows in the dialogue of "Knives Out" movie script.

There are 57 data identified as person deixis, and divided into three categories. First, there are 32 data of first-person deixis. Second, there are 12 data of second-person deixis. Third, there 13 data of third-person deixis. These data are identified as person deixis because in "Knives Out" movie script, there are several conversations between the speaker and the listener that pointing or indicating each other. They use this type of deixis when they want to call someone, referring to someone, and others.

There are 7 data classified as time deixis. These data are identified as time deixis because they contain deictic words that refers to the time when the events in the "Knives Out" movie script take place, such as 'today', 'now', et cetera. There are 2 data classified as place deixis. These data are identified as place deixis because they contain deictic words that refers to the location where the events in the "Knives Out" movie script take place, namely 'the house', et cetera.

There are 12 data are identified as social deixis. These data are identified as social deixis because they contain deictic words that refers to the differences in the social status between the speaker and the listener in "Knives Out" movie script, such as 'greatnana', 'mom', et cetera.

There are 11 data identified as discourse deixis. These data are identified as discourse deixis because they contain deictic words that refers to something that will be conveyed by the characters in order to explain the meaning more clearly in the "Knives Out" movie script, such as "this", and 'that'.

The total number of deictic words found in the utterances of "Knives Out" movie script is 89 data. Therefore, the most dominant type of deixis that I found in the "Knives Out" movie script is person deixis with the total of 57 data. Because, in my personal experience, during the conversation between each other, person deixis, in general, is the most common thing used by participants (the speaker and listener). By using person deixis, the referent becomes clear.

After completing this research, I am looking forward for the other researchers who interested in conducting the research of pragmatics, particularly in the field of deixis study. I recommend that researchers to explore the different types of deixis using another alternative source of data. These sources can be taken from the several written texts like newspapers, articles, novels, movie script, et cetera. Moreover, I encourage the readers, especially the students from English Language Department, to learn more about the study of deixis. Understanding deixis is important, because it enable other researchers to understand interpreting the intended meanings conveyed in utterances.
