

CHAPTER V CONCLUSION

The outcome of the intrinsic approach described with the extrinsic approach to demonstrate that the topic of this research is analysis of racial injustice against minorities in movie script entitled "*The Hate U Give*" (2018) by George Tillman Jr.

Plot and Setting used to analyze the script by George Tillman Jr. movie script entitled *The Hate U Give*. The exposition begins when Starr is still a small child, sitting in the dining room with her family as her father explains how to survive in this area. Complication begins when Starr has been seen as a teenager, attending a school with a majority of white students, and while erasing her old traditional lingo from her area.
