

CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of the Problem

Language is the means used by people to communicate with each other and to express their emotions and goals in communication. As social beings, humans must use language to communicate with one another on a daily basis. People will be unable to communicate with one another and will be unable to express their feelings, ideas, and opinions to others without the use of language.

According to Martina (2020:1), politeness is an important side in behaviour and interaction of human. Politeness do not only exist in daily interactions, but can also be displayed in the form of interactions on talk shows. When the host and the guests interact, they use many utterances to communicate each other which show politeness.

According to (Wikitubia Website, n.d.), HiHo Kids is a YouTube channel from America. This channel shows many varieties of videos such as Kids Meet, Kids Try, Kids Design, Kids Style and more. Kids Meet is a video series in which various children meet people from all over the world with various medical conditions, jobs, and stories. This video is shown on the HiHo kids YouTube channel. Many children have become well-known as a result of the series. One of them is the twin children; they are Helena and Ethan. Ethan is a boy and Helena is a girl. Ethan is usually seen with his glasses on, and Helena usually seen with her hair tied up. Helena and Ethan do not fight often and are extremely friendly with one another.

Based on the explanation above, I choose the research topic “Positive Politeness Used by The Twin Children and The Guests in *Kids Meet* YouTube Videos (2018-2020)” because I am interested and sure that there must be positive politeness strategies used by Helena, Ethan, and also the guests in *Kids Meet* videos when communicating with each other, because the guests are not close to these twin children and also the twin children are not close to the guest.

1.2. Identification of the Problem

Based on the background of the problem, I identify that there is a gap of age and different backgrounds between the twin children (Ethan and Helena) as the talents of HiHo with the guests they meet in *Kids Meet* who are adults which makes each other need an understanding between the language use in their utterance. 2. To explain the factors which influencing the use of positive politeness by Helena, Ethan, and the guests in the *Kids Meet* videos.
