The outcome of the intrinsic approach, which I further develop with the extrinsic technique, demonstrates that the research's theme is Anxiety Leads To Defense Mechanism Experienced By Grace As The Main Character In *Ready Or Not* Movie Script

The research results in the previous chapter can be concluded that anxiety and defense mechanisms can be matched with the film script of this story. Anxiety can result from a variety of factors, including social, psychological, and biological factors. To cope with anxiety, individuals may employ various defense mechanisms, which are unconscious processes that help defend against anxiety. I concluded that the main character Grace experienced three types of anxiety in her such as nervous, panic, and fear. She also experienced three types of defense mechanisms in her such as denial, intellectualization, and compensation.

games, which gave Graca an immense amount of anxiety. Grace was forced to play hide-and-seek in that game. Grace is unaware that the Le Domas family needs to eliminate her before sunrise in order to win the game. The fact that Alex attempted to convince her after ultimately betraying her. Grace's anxiousness thus led her to resort to a protective strategy.

The moral of the movie script is that it is very important to always be honest with your partner, and when one is in a relationship or married, communication is the key to success. If communication does not go well, there will be anxiety that arises and makes us unconsciously in a defense mechanism. Communicate with your partner the way you want to be treated.
