INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Problem

In communication, language is the most important things in social life. We use language to communicate with others. According to Oxford Learners Dictionary (Oxford Learners Dictionary, n.d.) language is the principal method of human communication, consisting of words used in a structured and conventional way and it conveyed by speech, writing, or gesture. Language has an essential role in society. We use language to express our thoughts, feeling, emotion, etc. In the use of language, language can be analyzed linguistically. Linguistic is the study of human speech including the units, nature, structure, and modification of language (Dictionary by Merriam-Webster, n.d.). Linguistics also deals with the meanings expressed by the speakers and will process by the hearers or the readers to produce the new information that will be associated with the excised information. In linguistic, there are two linguistic studies which related to the meaning.

There are semantic and pragmatic studies. Semantics is the study which focuses primarily on a speaker's ability to use the language system to produce meaningful speech and understand speech from others. While pragmatics is the study of language focused on someone's ability to derive meanings from specific kinds of speech to recognize what the speaker is referring to, and interpret what was said by the speaker. In semantics, analyzing meaning can be done in various ways, one of is by using the used figure of speech.

The used of figure of speech can also be seen in literary works, one of them is in the song lyrics. Some people love listening to music and read the song lyrics, and they tried to understand and interpret the meaning of each lyrics, but sometimes they have difficulties when understanding the meaning of each lyrics. When writing song lyrics, to make the lyrics of the songs much more meaningful and beautiful, song writers sometimes does not convey the true meaning of their songs, they often give the hidden meaning of their lyrics, because song writers do not want their listeners to know directly the meaning of the songs directly, they want their listeners to interpret the meaning first, so here can we conclude that figure of speech is words or phrases which meaning is separate from its literal meaning, the meaning we can find in the dictionary. Figure of speech is commonly use in literary works especially in the written of song lyrics.

Billie Eilish is a famous singer and song writer. She wrote her own lyrics then sing it too, when she was 15 years old, she gained attention with her first single debut "Ocean Eyes. From this song, Billie becomes more famous, and everyone around the world know her. She released her first album on March 29, 2019 "When We All Fall Asleep, Where Do we Go?" Then she released her second Album on July 30, 2021 "Happier Than Ever". Her second album could attract the attention of people around the world because of one of the songs in the album "Happier than ever". The "Happier than Ever" album received a total seven nominations at 64th Annual Grammy Awards, such as album of the year, best pop vocal album, song of the year, and record of the year.

The purpose why I conduct this research because as the music listeners, sometimes we find difficulties in understanding the meaning of the song lyrics. Every song has its own messages and in order to understand the message, the song need to be analyzed. I decided to' use the song lyrics of Billie Eilish album "Happier Than Ever" because, Billie as the singer and also the song writer wrote the lyrics in this album based on her life and experience also she is very good in words selection. In general, I expect that this study can make a positive contribution to help the readers to have better understanding about the meaning of the song lyrics in order to appreciate the song writer's work. This research can also help the next researcher who has some interest in analyzing the figurative language in the song lyrics
