**ABSTRACT**

*This research aims to determine an illocutionary act and understand a form of speech between the speaker and listener by using Sarle's illocutionary classification theory in the speech of the main character, The Queen Elizabeth II in the film script "The Crown" Season 4 (2021) Episode 1-7 Movie Script. This research was conducted using qualitative descriptive analysis methods. I collected this data and then tried to analyze it based on existing theories. The data is analyzed individually to determine which classification and speech act is most dominant. From these 35 data, there are four classifications of illocutionary acts used by the main characters in the script for the film "The Crown" Season 4 (2021) Episode 1-7 Movie Script. Based on the analysis carried out, illocutionary acts are more dominant in this research.*
