Chapter 1

In general, stand-up comedians are individual performers who plant themselves in front of their listeners with their microphones and start telling a succession of funny stories, one-liners or short jokes, and anecdotes, which are often called "bits", in order to make their audience laugh. The humorists' personalities, their interaction with the audience and their ability to spontaneously react to heckling are crucial aspects for successful stand-up comedy. Actually, there are so many steps and tricks to be a stand-up comedian. For example, they must prepare clearly the matter subject that they want deliver, the delivery of the matter subject must clear, and the timming of jokes must success. Then, stand-comedy have many terms on delivering the matter subject, like heckling, bit, punch and boom. In brief, stand up comedy is an expression that shows and delivers to the audience based on experiences and reflections of the way life with comedy aspect or comedy opinion.

In this section, the writer determines to analyze the stand-up comedy with politeness theory has relation with the messages that are delivered by stand-up comedian to the audience. In politeness theory, Brown and Levinson theorize that face must be continually monitored during a conversation because it is vulnerable. During a conversation face can be lost, maintained or enhanced. It is important to not only maintain one's own face but also the face of others. Interlocutors must be able to "save face" when they are confronted with a "face-threatening act" (FTA), which threatens the faces of the addressees.

Outline the four potential face-threatening acts, proposed by Brown and Levinson, as follows:¹

- 1.1.1 Acts which threaten the audience's negative face: ordering, advising, threatening, warning
- 1.1.2 Acts which threaten the audience's positive face: complaining, criticizing, disagreeing, raising taboo topics
- 1.1.3 Acts which threaten speaker's negative face: accepting an offer, accepting thanks, promising unwillingly
- 1.1.4 Acts which threaten speaker's positive face: apologizing, accepting compliments and confessing

The stand-up comedian who is standing in front of the audience and deliver material subject of jokes is Eddie Murphy. Edward Regan "Eddie" Murphy (born April 3, 1961) is an American stand-up comedian, actor, writer, singer, director, and musician

Box-office takes from Murphy's films make him the second-highest grossing actor in the United States. He was a regular cast member on *Saturday Night Live* from 1980 to 1984 and has worked as a stand-up comedian. He was ranked No. 10 on Comedy Central's list of the 100 Greatest Stand-ups of All Time.

He has received Golden Globe Award nominations for his performances in 48 Hrs., Beverly Hills Cop series, Trading Places, and The Nutty Professor. In 2007, he won the Golden Globe for Best Supporting Actor and received a nomination for the Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for his portrayal of soul singer James "Thunder" Early in Dreamgirls.

Eddie Murphy's work as a voice actor includes Thurgood Stubbs in *The PJs*, Donkey in the *Shrek* series and the Chinese dragon Mushu in Disney's *Mulan*. In some of his films, he plays multiple roles in addition to his main character, intended as a tribute to one of his idols Peter Sellers, who played multiple roles in *Dr. Strangelove* and elsewhere. Murphy has played multiple roles in *Coming to America*, Wes Craven's *Vampire in Brooklyn*, the *Nutty Professor* films (where he played the title role in two incarnations, plus his father, brother, mother, and grandmother), *Bowfinger*, *Norbit*, and *Meet Dave*.²

Murphy grew up in the Brooklyn neighborhood of Bushwick. His mother, Lillian, was a telephone operator, and his father, Charles Edward Murphy, was a transit police officer and an amateur actor and comedian. His father died when he was young. When Murphy's single mom became ill, the eight-year-old Eddie Murphy and his older brother lived in foster care for one year. In interviews, the actor and comedian says that his time in foster care was influential in developing his sense of humour. Later Murphy and his older brother Charlie were raised in Roosevelt, New York by his mother and stepfather Vernon Lynch, a foreman at an ice cream plant. Around the age of 15, Murphy was writing and performing his own routines, which were heavily influenced by Bill Cosby and Richard Pryor.

In stand-up comedy, there are so many tricks or the ways to deliver the meaning of subject material by stand-up comedian to the audience that be deserved to be analyzed with politeness theory. The interpretation of the audience is the essential problem of successfulness the meaning that is delivered by stand-up comedian to the audience. Then, the way stand-up comedian delivers the meaning with prosody, high pitch and gesture may cause the image that have contains in a story that is delivered by stand-up comedian.
