INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of the Problem

Slang is neither an official nor an informal language, but it is widely used for oral communication for a variety of purposes, as many words become obsolete due to changing trends. Slang has no formal classification, other than being a subclass of the language.

Slang words are frequently used in song lyrics, particularly in Travis Scoot's lyrics. Jacques Berman Webster II, better known by his stage name Travis Scott (formerly Travi\$ Scott), is an American rapper and record producer from Houston, Texas, best known for his appearance in Fortnite.

In Scott's first major-label deal came in 2012 with Epic Records. Scott signed a deal with Kanye West's GOOD Music in November of that year as part of its production wing Very GOOD Beats, following his appearance on the label's 2012 compilation album Cruel Summer. In April 2013, Scott signed with T.I.'s Grand Hustle Records imprint. Scott's first full-length project, a mixtape called Owl Pharoah, was self-released in May 2013. This was followed by a second mixtape, Day Before Rodeo, released in August 2014. His debut studio album, Rodeo, was released in September 2015 and featured the hit single, which peaked at number 20 on the US Billboard Hot 100 chart. His second album, Birds in the Trap Sing McKnight, came out in September 2016.

The following year, Scott and Quavo released a collaborative album called Huncho Jack, Jack Huncho under the name Huncho Jack. Scott released his third album, ASTROWORLD, in August 2018, which included his first Hot 100 number one single, Sicko Mode.

In this study, the author will explain Travis Scoot's slang lyrics, including "Yosemite," Sicko Mode, and others.

1.2. Identification of the Problem

Based on the context of the problem, we can see that Travis Scoot consistently uses slang in all of his songs. None of his songs are devoid of slang, which can make them seem strange because we haven't heard them before. As a researcher, I can see that Travis Scoot wants to use his songs from the 2018 ASTROWORLD album to promote himself.

1.3. Limitation of the Problem

The purpose of this research is to look at the slang used by Travis Scott in his music lyrics for the album ASTROWORLD. Travis Scott's music lyrics are unique in their meaning, and they can be interpreted in unique ways by a unique reader. The album contains 17 songs, and the writer will look at the slang phrases and characteristics that appear in those songs.

1.4. Formulation of the Problem

- 1. What type of slang words does Travis Scott use in his lyrics?
- 2. What are the most common slang words used in Travis Scott's lyrics?

- 2. To identify the dominant slang words found in Travis Scott's lyrics.
