CONCLUSION

After analyzing the data from the previous chapter, the author attempts to explain the study's conclusion. The lyrics to Travis Scott's song. Travis Scott's song lyrics represent the slang word above; from here, the slang is very important to understand when reading song lyrics. Slang in song lyrics is also a means of communication. The singer can communicate with the audience through the song. My research revealed that the slang word appears in every Travis Scott song, particularly on the album *ASTROWORLD* (2018). Travis Scott has seventeen songs with lyrics, including "Lazy," "Stargazing," "Carousel," "Sicko Mode," "R.I.P Screw," "Stop Trying To Be God," "No Bystanders," and "Skeletons." Wake Up, 5 Tint, NC-17, Astrothunder, Yosemite, Can't say, Who? What?, Butterfly Effect, Houstonfornication, and Coffee Bean.

According to George Yule's 1998 book, there are twelve different types of slang words. However, I discovered eight slang word formations in Travis Scott's song lyrics: clipping, blending, coinage, borrowing, compounding, multiplying, process, conversion, and acronym. Ain't (not), Gonna (going to), dawg (referring to friends), gon (the clipping word from going or gonna), livin' (living), and others are examples of slang words found in Travis Scott's song lyrics. This thesis used descriptive qualitative analysis; the writer chose descriptive qualitative analysis because it is used for discussing, analyzing, and identifying slang words. Because it is used as a word or phrase in analysis rather than a number. This method can be used to solve Statement Problem Number 1. Clipping accounts for 48%, blending 7%, coinage 23%, borrowing 1%, compounding 3%, multiplying 6%, conversion 6%, and acronym 6%.

The use of slang words in Travis Scott's lyrics is extremely useful. The purpose of slang words in song lyrics is to help readers or listeners understand the meaning of slang words and their types. The writer advised the song writer who used the slang word to choose the slang word because the writer discovered that the meaning of the slang word is extremely rude and impolite. However, everyone understands what is best for themselves. Thus, the author hopes that this study will be useful to other researchers, particularly students in the English Language and Culture Department.
